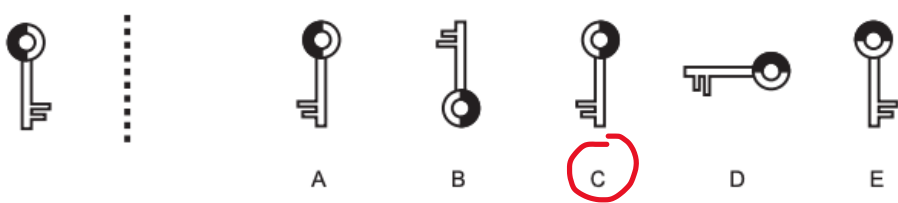
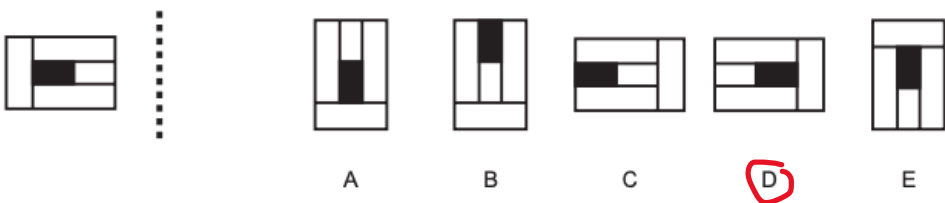
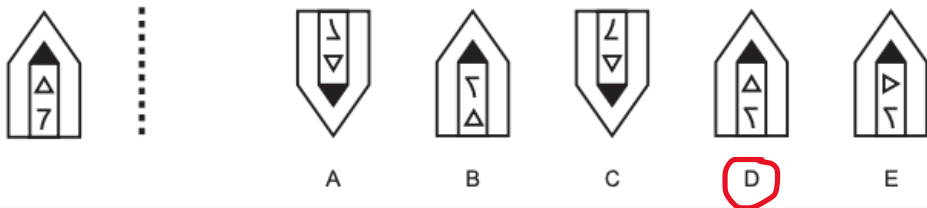
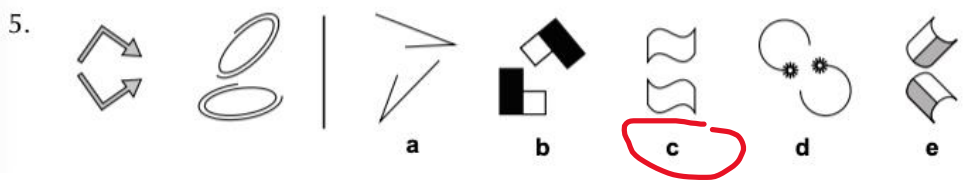
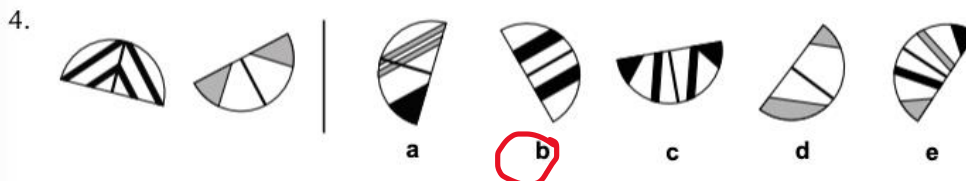
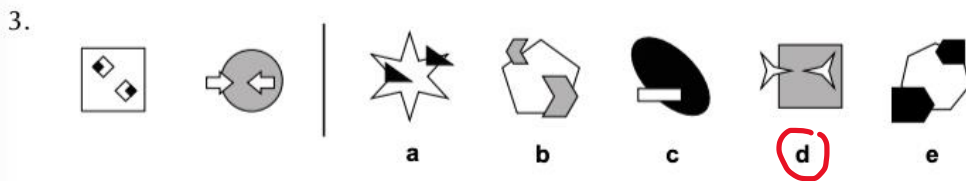
Find the Figure Like the First Two

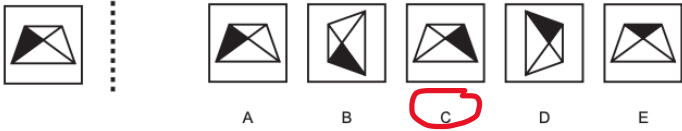
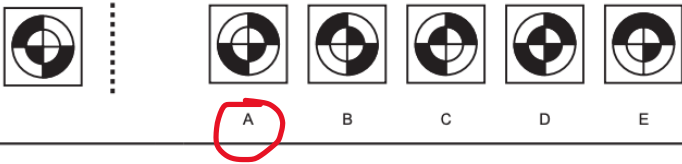
Find the figure on the right that is most like the two figures on the left.

Example:

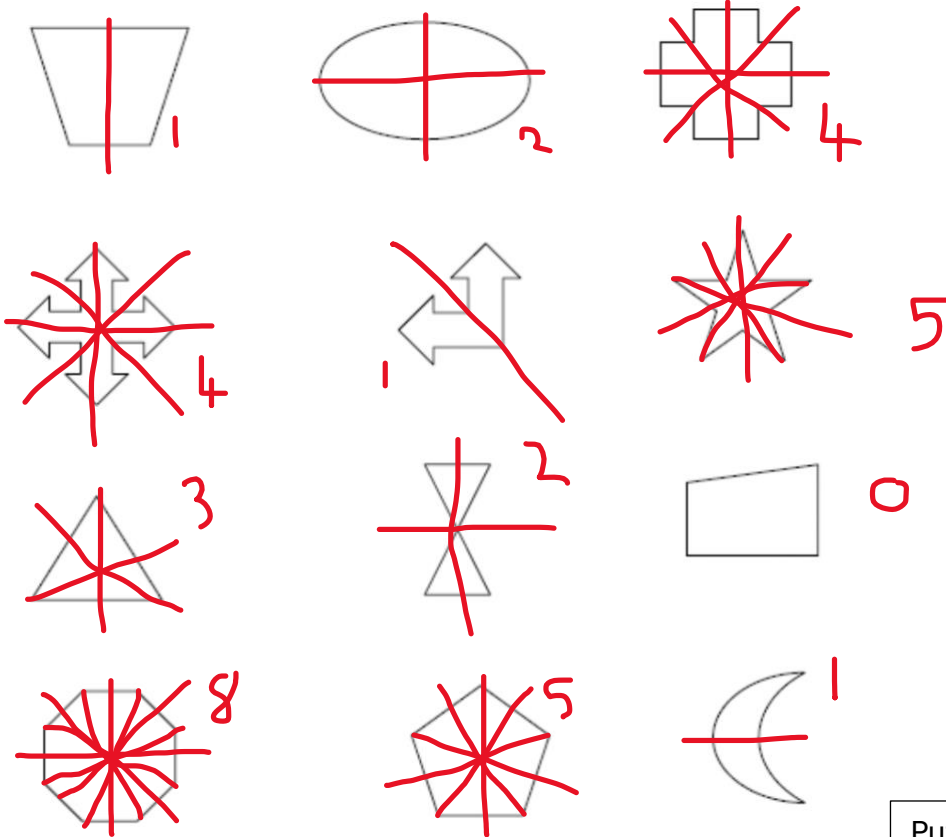


All figures must have a black shape and a white shape which are reflections of each other.



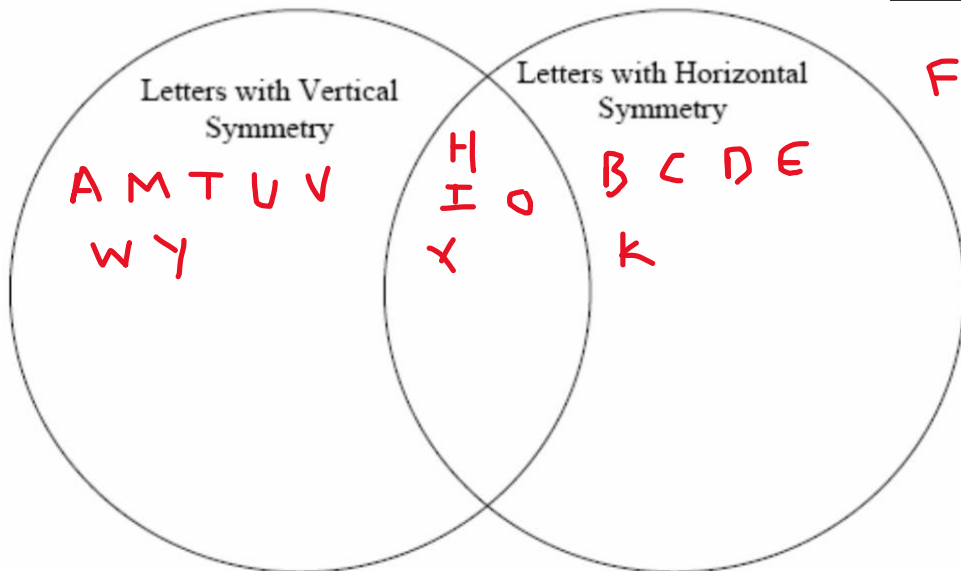


Find all the lines of symmetry
