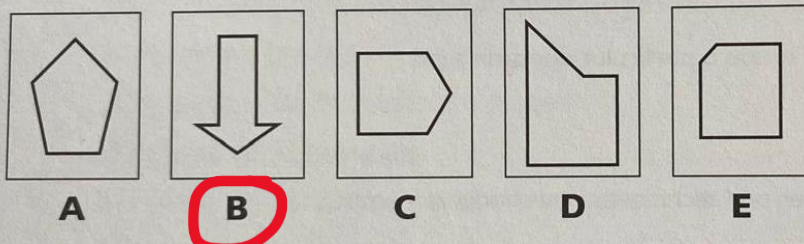

Non-Verbal – Shapes

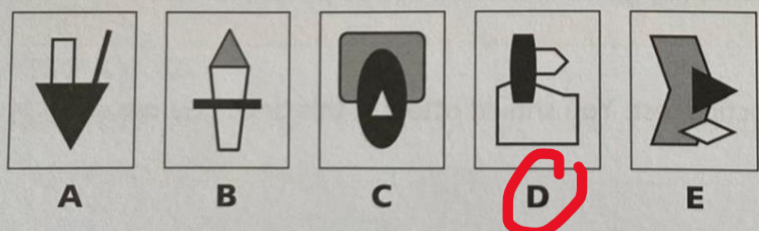
Which one is the odd one out and why?
